

Due to the current surge of COVID-19 cases in Northwest Arkansas, effective June 18th, Washington Regional Medical Center **will no longer allow visitors** for patients undergoing a surgical procedure or outpatient testing. This also applies to office visits.

Patients who *may* receive a visitor are:

Individuals who use a wheelchair or who have special needs (e.g., emotional instability, or cognitive impairment) where the presence of a single visitor may assist in patient care.

Patients allowed a visitor will only be permitted one (1) visitor who must be at least 18 years of age or older and pass Coronavirus screening.
